for Paint, Paint Aerosols, Flammable Liquids, Pesticides & Gasoline

STEP 1

To drop off any of these products, please go to the recycling bays and find a staff member.

Flammable Liquids

Acceptable products

Examples of products include

- Paint thinners
- Camp fuels
- Liquid adhesives.

Maximum container size:

10 litres

9 litres for kerosene

Flammable liquids must have:

The flammable symbol or have a warming such as "keep away from open flame or spark."

All acceptable products under the flammable liquids category must be a liquid.

or

Warning:

keep away from the open flame or spark

Paint

Acceptable products

- Latex, alkyd, enamel & oil-based paints
- Porch, floor & deck paints
- Interior & exterior varnishes & urethanes (single component)
- Primers, undercoats, block fillers and sealers
- Marine enamels (except anti-fouling paint & paint with pcp numbers treat as pesticides)
- Wood finishing oils, stains & shellac
- Latex (acrylic) driveway sealer
- Rust paint, decorative metal paints
- Fence, barn & swimming pool paint (single component)
- Wood and masonry water repellents
- Paint aerosols of all types, including automotive and industrial paint products

Maximum paint container size

23 L (5 gallons)

Limit

10 paint containers per visit

50 aerosol cans per visit



Gasoline

Acceptable products

This program accepts leftover gasoline products from such uses as lawnmowers, gas driven boats and other spark ignition engines. Caps & spouts on the containers should be checked to ensure they are properly sealed. Plastic wrap, paper, or things like shrink wrap covering the spout or cap is not acceptable.

Warning:

Gasoline is extremely flammable!

Maximum container size

25 litres

All gasoline products must be returned in a properly sealed III C

returned in a properly sealed ULC approved container.

Do not transfer gasoline from one container to another as it poses an extreme fire hazard, environmental impact from potential spillage



Pesticides liquids & solids

Acceptable products

Pesticides accepted under this program may be in a solid form or liquid form. They include such things as

- Weed killers
- Wood preservatives
- Anti-fouling paint
- Rat poison, etc.

Maximum container size

10 litres

Pesticide products must have:

Poison symbol (skull & cross bone) and pest control product registration (PCP) number.

Flammable liquid aerosol

Acceptable products

As well as paint aerosols and pesticide aerosols, the multi-drop program also accepts flammable liquids aerosols. They must meet the same criteria as for flammable liquids and solids categories.

Flammable liquids aerosols must have:

The flammable symbol or the warning symbol to "keep away from the open flame or spark."



or

Warning:

keep away from the open flame or spark

Pesticide aerosol


Acceptable products

As well as flammable liquids aerosols and paint aerosols, the multi-drop program also accepts pesticide aerosols. They must meet the same criteria as for pesticide liquids & solids categories.

Pesticide aerosols must have:

Both the poison symbol (skull & cross bones) and the pest control product registration (PCP) number.
